## **Signature Distribution Requirement for Initiatives Amendment**

## Proposed by AZ Legislature–AZ Constitutional Amendment

A **"yes"** vote <u>supports</u> establishing a signature distribution requirement for citizen initiatives, meaning that instead of requiring 10% of votes cast for governor statewide for initiated state statutes for the ballot, and 15% of votes cast for governor <u>statewide</u> to qualify initiated constitutional amendments for the ballot, the initiative would: •require signatures from 15% of votes cast for governor <u>in each legislative district</u> to qualify initiated constitutional amendments for the ballot. •require signatures from 10% of votes cast for governor <u>in each legislative district</u> to qualify initiated state statutes for the ballot. •require signatures from 10% of votes cast for governor <u>in each legislative district</u> to qualify initiated state statutes for the ballot.

The current law stipulates that the 10% and 15% can be gathered anywhere in the State. *Source: AZ Mirror article, 7/11/2024*
