

Proposition 137

End Terms Limits and Retention Elections for Judges and Justices

Proposed by AZ Legislature—AZ Constitutional Amendment

A "yes" vote supports ending term limits for state supreme court justices and superior court judges, replacing them with terms of good behavior unless decided otherwise by a judicial review commission, and would end retention elections at the end of the judicial term. *Source: Balletpedia*

The measure would be retroactive, meaning that if passed, any judges up for retention this cycle who fail their retention vote would be retained.
