In 2015, he secured reelection with the support of 75% of his constituency, having once again elevated voter engagement across all metrics in his district.

During his tenure, Councilmember and Vice Mayor Valenzuela prioritized enhancing public safety and community cohesion through innovative technology and Smart Policing Initiatives. He successfully advocated for the removal of the city's public safety hiring freeze and secured substantial federal grant funding to bolster the number of first responders. As Chair of the City of Phoenix Downtown, Aviation, Innovation, and Economy Subcommittee, Daniel played a pivotal role in realigning the city's economic development strategy to align with key sectors driving the Metro Phoenix economy, such as Healthcare, Advanced Manufacturing, Information Technology, Transportation, and Entrepreneurship.
